#### **Director Report:**

Students enrolled in independent study through Brigham Young University have completed their work and successfully passed their exams.

Mr. Cohen reports that we had 12 students participate in the CLEP test program this year. By far our largest number.

Cleaning service has been fired due to drug arrest. (No prior record). Temporary cleaner will be used for the last few weeks of school. Recommendation to advertise bid in July for new cleaning service.

In an effort to ease transition from 8<sup>th</sup> to 9<sup>th</sup> grade, Sandra Eble's 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> grade Language Arts class prepared a luncheon for the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> graders. 9<sup>th</sup> graders discussed the differences they had found and advised 8<sup>th</sup> graders on how they could prepare.

School Play was a huge success... Directed for the third consecutive year by Trudyann Buckley "West Moon Street", entertained approximately 75 guests each night.

Classroom doors will be retrofitted this summer to include glass windows. This was a recommendation from the Auditor General's Office.
