Reports: Jill reported on the mix up on IEP / GIEP. Since we received the Gifted IEP, we continue to write the Individual Education Plan for these students. In one of the invoice blocks asks IEP and we checked yes. The audit and the school districts, and NCLB never showed the problem. So we have been getting more money than we were supposed to get in the reimbursement. We contacted our lawyer and he said that there is no extra payment for GIEP. The PM said that the overpayment for this year can be reimbursed this year. The balance must be paid before the charter renewal, which gives us 18 months.
